

POST SECONDARY BURSARIES CRITERIA – INDIVIDUAL

Who is Eligible?

- → Must be a Registered Piikani Nation Band Members
- → Must be currently enrolled **FULLTIME** at an accredited Post Secondary institution or Trades Program.
- → High School Graduates must provide Transcripts.
- → Returning Students must have a GPA of 2.5
- → Bursary amounts are based on amount of applicants received as well as funding availability
- → Provide a report on the completion of program. Failure to provide a report may jeopardize future funding.

POST SECONDARY BURSARIES

Adult Upgrading Education

BURSARIES Students who apply may be eligible for a post secondary bursary.

Criteria:

- Must be a member of the Piikani Nation.
- Must be enrolled full time at an accredited post secondary institution.
- Must provide confirmation of official registration stating Fulltime status.
- Student must provide a letter from institution stating they are in good standing and maintaining a GPA of 2.5, and or a copy of the most recent transcripts
- Returning students must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher (in good standing)
- Provide a letter demonstrating financial need

Trades & Technical

BURSARIES Students who apply may be eligible for a post secondary bursary.

Criteria:

- Must be a member of the Piikani Nation
- Must be enrolled full time at an accredited post secondary institution
- Must provide confirmation of official registration stating Fulltime Status.
- Must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher (in good standing)
- New Students/High School graduates must provide a copy of most recent transcripts or Official high school transcripts
- Provide a letter demonstrating financial need
- Must add a Employee Apprenticeship Letter.

College/University

BURSARIES

Students who apply may be eligible for a post secondary bursary.

Criteria:

- Must be a member of the Piikani Nation
- Must be enrolled full time at an accredited post secondary institution
- Must provide confirmation of official registration stating Fulltime staus.
- Student must provide a letter from institution stating they are in good standing and maintaining a GPA of 2.5, and or a copy of the most recent transcripts
- Returning students must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher (in good standing)
- New/High School graduates must provide copy of most recent transcripts or Official high school transcripts
- Provide a letter demonstrating financial need

All Bursaries are based upon applications received & Funding Available.

A **PYEF Bursary** is a monetary award provided to Piikani Nation Members enrolled in a Post Secondary Program or Trades Program. The student must be **FULL TIME** Student currently enrolled in good standing with the Institution.

Application Criteria:

- → Must be currently enrolled **FULLTIME** at an accredited post secondary institution. Tuition Costs must be confirmed.
- → All applications will be reviewed by a Selection Committee
- → Applications must be received by the **DEADLINE January 18, 2019**
- → Successful Applicants; cheques will be processed within 5 7 days of meeting date.
- → PYEF will correspond verbally or written exclusively with applicant.

APPLICATION Must Include;

Bursary Application completely filled out.
Confirmation of full time status registration.
Letter from school stating in "Good Standing" and/or official
Transcripts.
Letter stating denial of finding from PBOE, Alberta Works, Service
Canada & Piikani Employment Services.
Must provide a Final Report at completion of School year end and
impact letter.
Trade application must include employer apprenticeship letter.
High School transcripts if first year in Post Secondary.
Letter demonstrating financial need.
Education Plan
Reference Letter
Copy of Piikani Indian Status

Please ensure you have all supporting documentation, PYEF will not process INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS
